FAKED TO PROSECUTOR

Sojourner

On 08-25-08 at 1336 hours, I, Officer Swanson and Officer Fournier were dispatched to 6016 Beachwood Rd. on a domestic. The text of the call stated the RP was reporting that her husband was hitting her and stated there were no weapons or alcohol involved. Lt. McKinley also responded to the scene as he was familiar with the parties from a prior incident.

Upon arrival, I observed Fournier talking to a male and female party. I walked up the driveway and Fournier stated he would talk to the male party who was identified as Isreal Ryan McKinney, DOB [REDACTED]. I talked with the female party who was verbally identified as Jennifer Howe Sauls McKinney, DOB [REDACTED].

I asked Jennifer what was going on and she stated that she had returned home a short time ago from a doctors appointment and that her husband, Isreal, had also returned home a short time ago as he was going to apparently work from home for the rest of the afternoon.

Jennifer stated she and Isreal have three children and stated she was also six months pregnant. Jennifer stated the nanny had taken two of their children, [REDACTED], DOB [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], DOB [REDACTED] from the residence for a while. Jennifer stated their other child, [REDACTED], DOB [REDACTED], needed to go down for a nap and she asked Isreal if she should put [REDACTED] down for a nap or if he wanted to. Isreal put [REDACTED] down for a nap but did not turn on the fan.

Jennifer stated [REDACTED] was fussing and she went into the bedroom and his fan was not on. Jennifer turned the fan on and Isreal came into the room and she had made a comment about having [REDACTED] fan on. Jennifer stated Isreal started to become argumentative and yelled at her and told her that she should just leave the fan on at all times.

Jennifer stated she was standing and holding [REDACTED] trying to comfort him. Jennifer stated she was trying to ignore Isreal as she did not want to argue in front of [REDACTED]. Jennifer stated Isreal took his open hand and hit her on the back side of her head. Jennifer stated Isreal did this out of anger. Jennifer stated she was in fear because of what had happened on 07-02-08 as Isreal was arrested at this time for domestic assault, case #08-1834.

Jennifer stated Isreal then grabbed her left elbow and then "flicked" her left ear with his finger. Jennifer was crying and upset. I asked Jennifer if she needed to be seen by paramedics and she stated no as she was not hurt. I did not observe any physical signs of injury. I asked Jennifer if she felt like she was going to drop [REDACTED] or anything when Isreal hit her and she stated no. Jennifer stated she and Isreal have been having marital problems and she stated she stayed at her parents' residence this past weekend. Jennifer stated Isreal asked her why she came back home and had made a comment about her taking the children with her as he apparently did not approve of this.

Jennifer stated Isreal was willing to go to counseling and stated that he is a good father and has never abused his children. Jennifer stated she would have no problems with Isreal being with the children as he is very good with them.

Jennifer stated her unborn son had some medical issues and that he has some kind of heart condition. Jennifer stated Isreal should be held accountable for his actions and that he does not

have the right to hit her. I talked with Officer Fournier while he was standing with Isreal. Fournier advised me that Isreal and Jennifer were arguing and that Isreal slapped Jennifer on the

cheek to get her attention and that he did not intend to hurt Jennifer. I advised Isreal he should never place his hands on Jennifer and that if they get into a verbal argument that one of them needs to walk away to let things cool down.

After talking with both parties, I advised Isreal he was being placed under arrest for 5th degree domestic assault. I had Fournier handcuff Isreal and Fournier then escorted Isreal to his squad.

I advised Jennifer that Isreal was placed under arrest for the domestic assault and she was crying and upset. I advised Jennifer I would be contacting Sojourner Project to report the incident to them. I cleared at 1425 hours and then returned to the police department.

Fournier booked Isreal and he was then transported to HC Jail by Minnetrista CSO Carlson. Officer Fournier completed a follow-up report in regards to the conversation he had with Isreal.

I contacted Sojourner Project and reported the incident to Megan.

On 08-25-2008 at approximately 1336 hours, I, Officer Fournier, assisted Officer Swanson with a domestic assault at 6016 Beachwood Rd. Dispatch said the reporting party's husband was hitting her.

I arrived on scene and met with the reporting party, Jennifer Howe Saul McKinney, DOB [REDACTED] and her husband Isreal Ryan McKinney, DOB [REDACTED] in the garage of the residence. Officer Swanson arrived and talked with Jennifer and I talked to Isreal.

I asked Isreal to tell me what happened. Isreal said Jennifer was ignoring him so he slapped her in the right side of her face. Isreal said his intentions were not to hurt Jennifer but to get her attention. I asked Isreal what they were arguing about and he said their son, [REDACTED] Isreal said he did not believe [REDACTED] needed to nap and an argument started. Isreal said he tried to talk to Jennifer but she would not acknowledge him. Isreal said he then slapped her with an open hand and demonstrated to me by slapping his right hand against his left. Isreal said Jennifer walked away and said she was going to call the police so he followed her outside the residence into the garage because he wanted to hear what she was going to say to the police. I asked Isreal where the argument took place and he said inside the residence in their son's bedroom.

I talked to Officer Swanson and we decided to arrest Isreal for 5th degree domestic assault. I placed Isreal in handcuffs and checked them for tightness making sure they were double locked. I placed Isreal in the back of my squad car and transported him and his belongings to the Mound Police Department where I completed a booking process.

Isreal was transported to the Hennepin County Jail by Minnetrista Community Service Officer Carlson.
