### INITIAL REPORT

NARRATIVE:  
SUMMARY:

On 1/25/2014 at 00:19 Jennifer H.S. McKinney was arrested for Domestic Disorderly Conduct and Criminal Damage to Property. She did post bond from the La Crosse County Jail and is staying with her mother.

### INITIAL CALL:

On 1/24/2013 at 23:29 Deputy Meoska and I were dispatched to ~~12345678901234567890~~ in the Town of ~~Hamilton~~ in reference to a possible Domestic in progress. The caller, Israel McKinney, stated that his wife, Jennifer McKinney, had just poured alcohol on him and threw a bottle of alcohol at him. Jennifer was upset with him for bringing alcohol into the house when they had five kids. It did not sound physical.

Due to Deputy Meoska's position and the extremely slippery roads, I did request assistance from Onalaska Officer Colgan. Officer Colgan arrived on scene at 23:46 hours.

I arrived on scene shortly after and made contact at the front door with Jennifer McKinney. I asked McKinney what was going on. McKinney stated that she is employed and has a good job and her husband is unemployed. She advised that money had been tight and that her husband, Israel McKinney, had gone to Buffalo Wild Wings and came home with a box which was full of vodka bottles and that the price of the vodka was about \$200.00. She said that Israel had been drinking alcohol, she did not like this, and that it only causes problems. Jennifer said that Israel had some store credit for some of the alcohol but still did have to pay a lot of their money for the alcohol. She was very upset about this.

She stated that she had a verbal fight with Israel and she got extremely mad and grabbed the vodka from the box and started throwing it and pouring it out the back deck. She said that when Israel was sitting on the couch in the living room, she took two open bottles of vodka and poured it on him and onto the couch. Jennifer stated that she did not threaten him or lay hands on him and neither did he threaten her or put hands on her.

Jennifer told me that she was not afraid of Israel and that they have had numerous domestic-type issues in the past and that they are seeing a counselor for this. I asked about any prior domestic abuse and she stated that approximately one week ago, Israel had held her down on the floor but did not cause her any physical pain. Jennifer said that she had lost her temper and acted inappropriately. She knew that what she did was wrong.

I then spoke with Israel who was speaking with Officer Colgan from the Onalaska Police Department. I noticed that Israel was visibly intoxicated and Israel told me that they had five kids inside of the house and that two of the kids had come down during the verbal incident. He stated that his children's names were K [REDACTED] age 9, C [REDACTED] age 7, M [REDACTED] age 6, S [REDACTED] age 5, and L [REDACTED] age 3.

Israel said that he got home from Buffalo Wild Wings and had bought a bunch of vodka but did have store credit for much of the vodka. He stated that Jennifer became extremely upset with him and started yelling at him and throwing vodka out of the back porch and pouring it all over. I asked him if Jennifer had thrown a bottle at him and he did not reply.

He then stated that he was sitting on the couch and Jennifer had taken bottles of vodka and poured it on him and onto the couch, soaking the couch cushions. I did observe the couch cushions and did see that there was a large amount of liquid on the couch cushions which would need to be professionally cleaned with a cost of approximately \$50.00.

Israel said that they have had many relationship issues in the past and that he had been arrested for domestic violence in the past but did not think that his wife should have acted this way.

### ACTION TAKEN:

I then explained to Jennifer that she was under arrest for Domestic Disorderly Conduct and Domestic Criminal Damage to Property. I allowed her to get her business credit card from Israel and escorted her outside of the residence. Once outside, I secured handcuffs around her wrists to the rear, safety locking, and checking them for tightness. A search of her person produced no contraband. Jennifer was then secured and seat belted in the rear of my squad. I then proceeded inside of the residence and issued Israel the Crime Victim sheet and asked him to complete a voluntary statement. He stated he would complete the statement and give the Sheriff's Department a call.

Officer Colgan stated that Israel had told him that he had the incident on his camera phone video and I provided my email address to Israel and he did state that he would email me the video.

I then cleared the scene en route to La Crosse County Jail.

### TURN-OVER/RELEASE:

During the entire contact with Jennifer, Jennifer explained to me that what she did was wrong and that she was just extremely upset for Israel's poor choices. Once at La Crosse County Jail, Jennifer was charged with Domestic Disorderly Conduct and Criminal Damage to Property. A No Contact was placed against Israel and the residence. I then cleared the scene.
